## WHAT TO WATCH FORIN ATLANTA THIS YEAR

Despite talks of a looming recession, labor is still in the driver's seat in the finance and accounting market. Employers should expect to pay more to attract and retain talent, especially with the much higher cost of living as a result of historic inflation. Big Four firms have responded to labor shortages by increasing pay for existing employees and potential candidates. KPMG stated most entry-level workers across audit, tax and advisory services in 2023 will earn salaries that are $5 \%$ to $\mathbf{1 5 \%}$ higher than those who joined in 2022, the firm said. Companies outside of the Big Four sector will need to follow suit in order to acquire top skilled Finance and Accounting professionals with a public accounting background.
In the Atlanta market, we can expect to see job seekers from the tech, as firms have slashed over 100,000 jobs across the U.S. since the start of the year, a wave of layoffs that impacted Atlanta firms including Salesloft, FullStory and Secureworks. However, what is happening in the tech sector belies the performance of the wider economy. U.S. payrolls increased by 517,000 in February, well above the 187,000 market estimate. To fill talent gaps, wages continue well above their prepandemic rate of $2-3 \%$, and rose to $4.4 \%$ over the past year. Other hiring trends that may build a broader candidate pool include hybrid or remote work, improved benefits, pay transparency, and employee wellness programs.
